Corner Brook Port's First Cruise Ship Arrival of the Season

CORNER BROOK – Corner Brook Port Corporation will welcome the first ship of the 2014 cruise season on Friday, May 30. The *Oceania Marina* (Oceania Cruises) will arrive at 8 a.m. and spend a full day in port, departing at 5 p.m. The ship, which was launched in 2011, has a capacity of 1,250 passengers and 800 crew. The Marina was also the first cruise ship of the season in 2013, making its inaugural call to Corner Brook on June 3.

Oceania Cruises specialize in offering sophisticated, personalized service aboard its five mid-sized cruise ships. Some of the more unique offerings onboard Marina include a hands-on cooking school and an artists-in-residence program. The vessel is on a 35 day *Mythical Travels* itinerary which departed from Lima, Peru on May 6, will cross the Atlantic Ocean and return to Europe to conclude in London, England on June 7. Upon departure from Corner Brook, the vessel is scheduled to visit L'Anse Aux Meadows on May 31.

Corner Brook Port Corporation is expecting 9 cruise ship visits this season. Following the first call on May 30, the next scheduled call will be the inaugural call of the Veendam (Holland America Line) on July 15. The cruise ship Astor (Transocean Cruises) will arrive on July 23. The remaining six calls are scheduled for the fall and include the Amadea (Phoenix Reisen) on September 3, the Celebrity Summit (Celebrity Cruises) on September 17 and October 1, Silver Whisper (Silversea Cruises) on September 22 and the Oceania Regatta (Oceania Cruises) on September 24 and October 2.
