- **1** Big Falls Trail. In July & August see salmon jump the salmon ladder to get further upstream to spawn. Sir Richard Squires Memorial Provincial Park, Route 422, Cormack.
- 2 Corner Brook Stream Trail. Trail network in & around Corner Brook, cbstream.com
- 3 Deer Lake Walking Trails. Stroll along the sandy beaches of Deer Lake and the meandering Humber River. Route 1, Deer Lake; deerlake.ca
- Governor's Staircase. 30-minute climb through 450 million year old volcanic rock. Route 450, Blow Me Down Provincial Park,

Ascend 2.5 km & 300m to the top of the 'Old Man in the Mountain' for breathtaking views.
