

*Canadian Navigable Waters Act*

**Corner Brook Port Corporation** hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act,

**Corner Brook Port Corporation** has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Navigable Waters Registry (<https://common-project-search.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 968, or, under the NPP File Number 2004-700262 a description of the following work, its site and plans:

- Removal of Debris (boulders)

in, on, over, under, through or across Humber Arm (Atlantic Ocean), immediately adjacent to the main wharf structure at the Corner Brook Port, located at 48° 57' 36.39" N, 057° 56' 34.64" W. Photographs are available through the on-line Navigable Waters Registry noted above.


